FROM THE CDC WEBSITE:

HOW DO I KNOW IF I HAVE THE FLU?

You may have the flu if you have some or all of these symptoms: fever; cough; sore throat; runny or stuffy nose; body aches; headache; chills; fatigue; sometimes diarrhea and vomiting.

*It's important to note that not everyone with flu will have a fever.

WHAT SHOULD I DO IF I GET SICK?

If, however, you have symptoms of flu and are in a high risk group, or are very sick or worried about your illness, contact your health care provider (doctor, physician's assistant, etc.).

Certain people are at high risk of serious flurelated complications (including young children, people 65 and older, pregnant women and people with certain medical conditions) and this is true both for seasonal flu and novel flu virus infections.
